

International Students Termination of Tuition Policy

Reviewed March 2011

Tuition at Owairaka District School may be terminated for any of the following circumstances:

1. If a student is asked to leave the school because of misbehaviour, violation of school rules or the Education rules 1999 in regard to stand-downs, suspensions, exclusions and expulsions.
 - Refer to International Student Policy & Pupils Behaviour School Expectations, www.minedu.govt.nz
2. If a student fails to attend school without just cause
 - Refer to Attendance Policy
3. If New Zealand Immigration Service revokes the students permit for any reason.
 - Refer to www.immigration.govt.nz
4. A student returns to their home country because of serious illness
 - Refer to Refund Policy
5. A student returns to their home country because of death or serious illness of a close member of the student's family and cannot return within a reasonable time.
 - Refer to Refund Policy
6. Criminal Acts
 - Refer to International Student Policy
7. The school not being advised if there is a change of Contract details.
 - Refer to International Student Policy
8. Unpaid fees
9. Inadequate progress by the student
10. Provision of false or misleading information by the student on enrolment.
